



## Lois Hammond Scholarship Criteria

- The student must be accepted into a University/Tertiary institution
- Must submit two letters of recommendation: One from your high school principal, guidance counselor/teacher, a minister of religion or a Justice of the peace.
- Proof of extra-curricular activities/volunteer services: Letter from the individual in charge of extracurricular/volunteer program must be submitted.
  - Items to be addressed in the letter:
    1. How did participating in the extra-curricular activities or volunteer services enhanced the school and or community?
    2. What is your experience with the applicant?
    3. Student's potential to succeed at their next learning institution
- 1-2page essay, answering the following questions:
  1. How will receiving the scholarship impact your life?
  2. How will winning the scholarship effect your community at large?
  3. What are your career goals and aspirations?
  4. Who has been a role model for you?
  5. Is there anything else you would like to add?

### **Special consideration will be offered to the student who makes the most compelling case.**

- Proof of financial hardship.
  - Parent's income is below the poverty level (Provide Evidence)
- First generation college student (neither parent went to college)
- The student must have at least five subjects that are accepted by the institution.
- Student who has lost a parent to cancer or is currently undergoing treatment will be given a higher priority, providing they satisfy the guidelines set by the board of directors.
